About the School



The academic year

Recently in 2014-15 the school Volley Ball team won 6th Dayasindhu Volley Ball District Championship held at Lord Mahavira School, Saharanpur. The School Volley Ball team played quarterfinal at CBSE Cluster Level Championship held at Muzaffarnagar. Our three students reached in 100 mt. final & one in 400 mt. final heat in Mini Olympics held at Sports Stadium, Saharanpur in 2014-15. School Volley Ball team emerged as winner in Volley Ball Tournament held at Shobhit University, Gangoh in 2013-14. In the same year Vijay Pratap won Gold in National Taekwondo Championship, Mumbai. School Cricket Team became runner up in Shri Shishupal Raghav Memorial Cup in Dehradun. Before this also the students have shown their remarkable performance in different tournaments.

Besides, our students participate in different competitions & Olympiads of G.K., English, Maths, Science, S.Science etc. Our student Vertika secured 3rd place at State level in the Competition on Environment conducted by SAVIOR in 2013-14. Urvashi won cash Award of Rs 10,000 in English Olympiad.

Debates

The students are trained to participate in debates organized by the school from time to time. The students are encouraged to express their own views openly, boldly to the topic allotted to them, especially on the current events.

Transport

The School has arranged a well organized transport facility in a radius of 20 Km. around Nanauta. We cater more than 20 routes in and around Nanauta, keeping in the mind of the need of the parents. The service is available at all the residential points around Nanauta.

Educational Tours and Excursions

The School also conducts Counseling Tours to various Technical Points to make them updated regarding upcoming new career fields and to help them choose the career according to present day demand.



Parent-Teacher Meeting

Good working relationships between students, teachers and parents are essential to ensure all students to reach their full potential; keeping in this view the school organizes Parent-Teacher Meeting from time to time to discuss the problems faced by the students regarding their studies. By doing so parents remain in permanent contact with teachers and a transparency is maintained. It also helps parents to talk freely over students' problems and achievements to channelize a child's interest in a positive direction to obtain the desirous and fruitful result.

About school Uniform : Summer

For Girls : In the summer session the girl student upto class V will wear chocolate brown skirts with box pleats upto the knees, Plain Lemon blouses, Ties, School Belts, Brown Socks, Black leather Shoes, Red ribbon and Identity Card. Those above class V will wear Plain Lemon Shirt, Chocolate Brown Salwar, Chocolate Brown Dupatta, Brown Socks, Black leather Shoes, Red Ribbon and Identity card.



For Boys : Chocolate Brown pants, Plain Lemon shirt, Ties, School Belts, Brown Socks, Black leather Shoes and Identity Card.

Winter :

For Girls : The same uniform as in summer season along with Mustard Brown cardigan, School Blazer with school crest and Chocolate Brown caps.



For Boys : The same uniform as in summer season along with Mustard Brown Sweater and Blazer with school crest and Chocolate Brown caps.

Note : On every Saturday, all the students will wear the uniform prescribed as above except that it would be in white colour along with white canvas shoes. For girls the colour of Dupatta will remain Chocolate Brown.

Rules for admission

The students who is willing to take admission to any class, will have to undergo a written Admission Test of English, Hindi, Mathematics and Science to be held on a definite date declared at the time of admission. Only those who clear the Admission Test will be granted admission. In cast the student fails to clear the test, he/she will not be allowed for admission. In this regard no approach will be entertained and the decision of the school management (Examination Committee) will be final. Before appearing at the admission test, the student will have to get registered himself/herself for the test to be held. They will have to produce T.C. issued from the competent authority. Without T.C. no admission will be granted. Those who are freshers and seek admission to Nursery classes will have to produce the Date of Birth Certificate issued from the competent authority.

Subject Option

In classes VI to VIII students have the option to choose any language either Sanskrit or Urdu as a third language as suggested by C.B.S.E. XI Science stream students will have the above mentioned subject option :-

Withdrawal

1. Notices of withdraw from school or discontinuance of the school should be submitted one month in advance otherwise the tuition fee and transportation charges for the current month will be charged in full.
2. If a child is withdrawn in mid-session, monthly fee for the remaining months till the completion of the session will be charged.
3. Those who leave the school in the month of May must, in all cases, pay the fee for the month of June.
4. Transfer Certificate will not be issued until all dues of the school are settled.
5. A student can be asked to leave the school on grounds of sheer indiscipline.
6. Students caught cheating, bullying, rude behaving, showing disrespect to teachers or bringing disrespect to the school by any form of behaviour not acceptable to the school will be expelled. The Principal's decision in these cases is final.
7. Boys who do not benefit from the school or make little progress may be asked to leave the school.
8. Admission fee and other charges are non-refundable in any case.

A word to the parents

1. All the students are expected to speak in English while in the school. We request the parents to do so at home as well.
2. Parents are advised to be conscious about the fact that the school is actually a supplement to the home and not its substitute. It is very important that Parents/Guardians extend unstinted co-operation to the school in all matters concerning their wards.
3. Parents must ensure that their wards do not carry any electronic articles such as Mobile Phone, Camera, Walkman, Music Player etc. to the school. Possession of such items by students in the school is treated as an offence and all such items will be immediately confiscated and will not be returned at all.
4. In case any legitimate complaint or if you feel your ward is not making the desired progress, you should meet the Principal at the earliest or write to him/her personally.
5. Parents' attention is drawn to the fact that the criticism of the teacher of the school in the presence of a child should be scrupulously avoided because it may develop in the students the tendency to lose respect towards teachers.



Etiquettes and moral standard

1. Students are expected to observe discipline and decorum in their behaviour in and outside the school as it reflects the image of the school.
2. Students should always be ready to lend a helping hand to their parents, siblings, in school to teachers and companions.
3. Students should never cheat or be unfair and should be truthful always.
4. Respect and appreciate the beauty of the classroom and your school premises. School property like furniture, wall etc should not be defaced or damaged. The culprit will have to make up for any damage done; in addition a fine shall also be imposed.
5. Students are not allowed to wear jewellery, expensive watches, bracelets etc. in the school. In case of loss, strict disciplinary action may be initiated against erring students.
6. Students are not allowed to bring any sharp instrument/weapons like blade, knife or any other subject which can cause injury.

Mobile Phones

The possession and use of Mobile Phones is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Students with such instruments in their possession will be severely punished. The Mobile Phone will be confiscated and will not be returned under any circumstances.
